6. Re-read **1 John 2:15-17**. Verse 16 mentions three things that are not from God. a) Which do you struggle most with? b) What is one thing you can do this week to help yourself with the struggle?
7. Read **Revelation 15:3-4** again. Close by worshipping God with prayers somewhat patterned after these lyrics of praise.
