WARMING UP...

2. Out of the four names of the Messiah that we explored in Isaiah 9:6, is there one name in particular that impacted or challenged you?

LOOK TO THE BOOK...

3. The Messiah is a "Hero" who will come and make things right. With this in mind, read about the context in which the prophet Isaiah was serving in according to Isaiah 1:1-17.
4. Why is God angry with His people according to this passage? What issues need to be addressed – what needs to be made right? List as many specific examples as possible.
5. How does verse 17 correspond to what we have been learning this summer about Active-Faith? Refer to James 2:14-19 in your discussion.

6. Are there any parallels that we can draw between people of Judah in Isaiah 1:1-17 and what we might struggle with today? (Avoid any specific or personal examples).
7. What are some of the ways that we can guard ourselves and encourage one another from falling into a similar trap as the people of Isaiah 1:1-17?
8. What role can our Home Church communities play in that process?
